### Application form for Higher Level Bursary

**Bursary Amount:** The bursary is currently worth up to £1,200. Payable in three instalments in October, February and April.

**Eligibility:** The student must fall into one of four categories

- a) In Care
- b) Care Leavers
- c) Receiving Income Support (IS), or Universal Credit (UC) **in their own name** because they are financially supporting themselves or financially supporting themselves and someone who is dependent on them and living with them such as a child or partner
- d) Receiving Disability Living Allowance (DLA) or Personal Independence Payments (PIP) **in their own right as well as** Employment and Support Allowance (ESA) or Universal Credit (UC) **in their own right**

**Evidence:** Please supply evidence relating to the eligibility category as stated above

- a) Letter from Social Worker
- b) Letter from Social Worker
- c) Copy of letter from DWP dated within three months of application. **All** pages must be submitted.
- d) Copies of letters from DWP dated within three months of application for both benefits. **All** pages must be submitted.
